

## Report Cards:

At the PreK-6 levels we have adopted a standards based report card which is completed electronically in our management system (STI). Teachers rate students on a quarterly basis in the subject areas and in standards based subcategories. Each subcategory is rated as 1- above standard, 2 at standard or 3 below standard. At K-3 the subjects are rated similarly considering the ratings of that subject subcategories. At the 4-6th grade levels the subjects are given traditional A-F letter grades. 4-6th grade teachers may use the grade book part of STI to track and assign subject grades and subcategory ratings. Report card guidelines are developed which provide teachers with an understanding of what performance levels constitute “at standard performance” each quarter.

7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students receive traditional A-F grades based on the following grade score percentages:

A	=	90%+
B	=	80% - 89%
C	=	70% - 79%
D	=	60% - 69%
F	=	59% ↓

Test scores, quizzes, projects and homework are entered into the STI grade book program to create a quarterly grade score that is converted to a letter grade. The STI program generates a printed report card that is mailed home.
